Establishing 13 research teams and facilitating **raising funds for research of roughly \$6.1M**; some of those teams later constituted GRAPE, an independent non-governmental research center operating in Warsaw.

GRAPE provides internship and assistantship opportunities for young scholars in Poland, fosters international cooperation, hosts and organizes international conferences (including GenderGaps Conference 2016 and “Shadow Economy, Tax Evasion and Informal Labor” in 2017). Currently, GRAPE houses a team of 17 researchers (junior and senior). An element of GRAPE's mission is to provide general public with insights into economic analyses of the policy-relevant topics. GRAPE has developed inter alia:

- a profound overview of the job brokering deficiencies in Poland (utilizing an RCT, covered by all major dailies, radio, TV as well as weeklies and Bloomberg International ([link](#)),
- an analysis of the fiscal and welfare consequences of reducing the minimum eligibility retirement age (with 150K+ views) and viability of the implemented pension system (with 84+K views),
- an evaluation of the children malnutrition policies in Poland (utilizing RCT, covered by all major dailies, radio and TV).

As of mid 2017 GRAPE has a weekly op-ed in one of the major Polish dailies.

Feeding into **public debate**, i.a. with 6 annual labor market reports (designed, co-authored and edited, these reports were second most popular report of NBP, next only to inflation forecasts) as well as timely analyses of labor market and household sector; between 2013 and 2015 a weekly radio show popularizing economics.
